Where?

At Moyock Elementary School, and at Jarvisburg Elementary School, in their respective gymnasiums.

When?

Six consecutive Saturdays, starting on January 21st. The first group lesson will begin at 9:00 a.m., and each hour thereafter. The program will conclude on Saturday, February 23rd.

Teachers?

Lessons at Moyock Elementary School will be taught by Vic Ramsey, varsity tennis coach at Currituck County High School. Lessons at Jarvisburg will be taught by Bob Kohler. Other instructors and assistants will be used at each site.

Who?

For children, teenagers, and adults of all abilities. Children and youth must be enrolled in the kindergarten or higher. Students will be grouped based on age, experience, and ability.

What to bring?

Your tennis racquet (if you do not have one, a racquet will be provided for you to use). Wear tennis shoes, and dress in appropriate tennis/athletic clothing.

What will be taught?

Beginners will learn basic strokes, how to keep score, tennis etiquette, and other beginning skills. Intermediate and advanced players will receive instruction based on individual needs.

The program will be based on the popular Quick-Start format currently being promoted by the United States Tennis Association. This format involves short courts, slower balls, and lower nets to help beginners master the fundamentals and play competitive games quickly.
