

Currituck USTA Junior Team Tennis

12- and 14-and-Under Divisions

What?

In concert with the United States Tennis Association, Currituck Tennis is sponsoring a Junior Team Tennis League this spring.

The teams are co-ed: boys and girls will play on the same teams. Students do not have to have any prior tennis experience in order to participate.

Players are eligible if they do not turn 15 years of age by August 31, 2018.

When?

Students at Currituck Co. Middle School will practice on Wednesdays, immediately after school, on the high school courts.

Students in the 12-and-under division at Moyock Middle School will practice on Thursdays, immediately after school, on the courts at Moyock Middle. Students in the 14-and-under division will practice on Tuesdays, immediately after school, also at the Moyock Middle School courts.

Practices begin the week of March 20th.

Once registration is complete, players will be divided into teams of 5-6 players, with a coach assigned to each team.

The season begins on April 26th, and continues through the first week of June. Matches will take place at the high school, on Thursday evenings, beginning at 6:00 p.m.

Coaches

The program at Moyock Middle will be supervised by Christy Hodges and Allison Nekervis. The program at Currituck Middle will be supervised by Vic Ramsey. Members of the CCHS girls team, and parents, will assist and serve as team coaches.

Transportation

Parents, not coaches, are responsible for arranging transportation to all practices and matches. We can help set up car-pooling and ride-sharing arrangements, but, because this program is not an official school sport, we do not have access to activity buses.

How to Register

Junior Team Tennis is a USTA-sanctioned program. As such, USTA membership is required of all participants.

The junior rate for USTA membership is \$20.00 per year. USTA membership includes a magazine subscription and other privileges, including the opportunity to participate in other USTA-sanctioned leagues and tournaments.

In addition to the USTA membership fee, there is a league fee of \$10.00.

Both the USTA membership and the league fee must be paid prior to attending the first practice, and the fees are not refundable. Both fees are paid online, and you will find detailed instructions on the reverse side of this flyer.

Return the form below to the school office, which will give your child permission to remain after school for practice. Please do not send any money to the school. All registration fees are paid online.

Instructions for joining USTA and Enrolling in the Junior Team Tennis League

Joining the USTA

USTA memberships for children under the age of 14 must be managed by one of their parents. To do so, the parent will need to create a "USTA account". This is free to the parent.

From this account, the parent will purchase a membership for the child, and create a USTA account for the child.

To create the parent's USTA account ...

- Go to www.usta.com.
- In the top banner, click on the blue "TennisLink" link.
- Click on the red "Login" button.
- Click on the "Create Account" button under the paragraph that begins ... "TennisLink give you access to play opportunities ..."
- Follow the prompts to create your USTA account. You'll need an email address as a username, and you'll create a password.

To purchase your child's USTA membership ...

- Go to www.usta.com.
- Click on the blue "login" link in the upper right-hand corner.
- Sign into the parent's USTA account. *(If you used the same email address for your USTA account that you use for Facebook, then you can click the "Sign on with Facebook" box to sign in.)*
- Click the blue "Join" button for a first-time membership, or the red "Renew" button for a membership renewal.
- On the next screen, select a junior or family membership.
- On the next screen, select the membership duration of your choice.
- On the next screen, select "add a family member", and complete the prompts to purchase your child's USTA membership.
- At the end of the process, your child will be assigned a USTA membership number. Your child's USTA account will be created, and will be linked to your parent account. To sign your child up for Junior Team Tennis or a USTA sanctioned tournament, you'll do so through your parent account.

To Enroll in the USTA Jr. Team Tennis League

- Go to www.usta.com.
- Click on the blue "TennisLink" link in the top banner on the right side of the page.
- Click on the red "LOGIN" button, and enter the email address and password associated with your parent account.
- Hover over the "Junior Team Tennis" tab, and click on the "Find a Program" button.
- Search by city and state, using Barco NC 27917.
- Click on the "2018 Currituck Spring JTT" link, and you'll be taken to the main program page.
- Click the red "Register Now" button.
- Select the age-division and USTA membership number for your child. If you wish to register more than one child, you may do so in the spaces provided.
- Click "Submit", and follow the prompts to complete the online payment process.

Register by March 20th in order to attend the first practice.
Final registration deadline is Friday, April 6th.
